<b>Pay to Play: Free!</b>
<b>Overall Distance: 2041 ft</b>
<b>Shortest/Longest Hole: #5-165' / #7-280'</b>
<b>Parking: Free parking lot near hole 1</b>
<b>Terrain: One small hill and grassy</b>
<b>Shade: Minimal while playing</b>
<b>Spotter Need: No</b>
<b>Popularity: Park overall pretty popular not so much the course.</b>
<b>Out of Bounds (O.B.): None in play</b>
<b>Pedestrian Traffic: Light to Moderate</b>
<b>Favored Shot Type: Use a putter however you want...</b>
<b>Speed of Play: Can finish 18 holes in forty minutes.</b>
<b>Layout Quality: Short, but avoids most populated parts of park.</b>
<b>Tee pad Type: Grass</b>
<b>Basket Type: Mach V</b>
<b>Signage: On all holes, shows positions and lengths, plus O.B., metal</b>
<b>Critter Concerns: Children</b>
<b>Pesky Plants: None to really report here.</b>
<b>Favorite Hole: Hole 9 because it plays the longest shooting uphill most of the way</b>
