

Kuna Disc Golf Course

Pay to Play: Free!
Overall Distance: 4996'
Shortest/Longest Hole: #14-143' / #15-446
Parking: Free dirt parking lot near hole 1
Terrain: Few small hills, mostly flat, grassy.
Shade: Moderate –Final 6 holes have little to no shade
Spotter Need: No
Popularity: Very popular recreation area. Hole 1 can have lots of non-disc golf traffic, potential for some backups on holes.
Out of Bounds (O.B.): Creek on south side of park and some private property on north side of last 6 holes.
Pedestrian Traffic: Light to Moderate
Favored Shot Type: RHFH for over 90% of the drives.
Speed of Play: Pretty fast
Layout Quality: Good use of available land, a couple fairways end up on top of each other, keep an eye out!
Tee pad Type: Concrete
Basket Type: Innova DISCatcher
Signage: No signage, bring map, or take picture of map at hole 1
Critter Concerns: People
Pesky Plants: None to really report here.
Total Holes: 18
Favorite Hole: Hole 4 is a short RHFH bomb busting out of tree cover

Just a Heads Up...

This is a popular multi-use park a lot of which has its own area that the disc golf course avoids, but keep an eye out for pedestrians and expect hole 1 to be a bit of a mess. Avoid going in the creek at all costs as water is moving swiftly and disc will likely be lost. Drives on this course heavily favor the RHFH shot, so if you need to practice that shot or its equivalent this is the place to go!
