

# Lake Walcott State Park Disc Golf Course

<b>Pay to Play:</b> Day use fee of \$5 – Camping costs vary
<b>Overall Distance:</b> 6115'
<b>Shortest/Longest Hole:</b> #11-120' / #5-540'
<b>Parking:</b> Paved parking near hole 1
<b>Terrain:</b> Grassy throughout with a few small scattered elevation changes.
<b>Shade:</b> Course is mostly mix of light to heavily wooded making for good shade, but a few holes are wide open with no shade
<b>Spotter Need:</b> No
<b>Popularity:</b> Probably want to avoid this park on a holiday, but otherwise there shouldn't be too many people to deal with ever.
<b>Out of Bounds (O.B.):</b> A few opportunities to go into the lake, but for most part there is no O.B.
<b>Pedestrian Traffic:</b> Very Light
<b>Favored Shot Type:</b> Due to most hole's distances I would favor a backhand shot over forehand shot for both lefties and righties.
<b>Speed of Play:</b> Moderate – nothing in particular causes delays.
<b>Layout Quality:</b> Just superb!!!! Great mix of shots and distances!
<b>Tee pad Type:</b> Rubber
<b>Basket Type:</b> Innova DISCatcher
<b>Signage:</b> Signage on all holes. Metal poles with paper behind plexiglass. Somewhat old and faded on some holes.
<b>Critter Concerns:</b> Lots of critters out here, but the only thing to worry about are raccoons getting in your cooler lol.
<b>Pesky Plants:</b> None to really report here.
<b>Total Holes:</b> 21
<b>Favorite Hole:</b> Hole 12 because it was my fourth ace! High Risk Shot!
