

# Slate Canyon Disc Golf Course

<b>Pay to Play:</b> Free!
<b>Overall Distance:</b> 4950'
<b>Shortest/Longest Hole:</b> #8-167' / #10-400'
<b>Parking:</b> Free dirt parking lot near hole 1
<b>Terrain:</b> VERY STEEP, DRY, AND DUSTY
<b>Shade:</b> Minimal during most hours of the day
<b>Spotter Need:</b> No, but keep an eye on your throw
<b>Popularity:</b> Had the course to ourselves on a Friday evening in the summer.
<b>Out of Bounds (O.B.):</b> None
<b>Pedestrian Traffic:</b> None
<b>Favored Shot Type:</b> Varied, often shot was dictated by which side of the tee pad the hill was on.
<b>Speed of Play:</b> Slow to start, potential for fast or slow finish
<b>Layout Quality:</b> Layout is pretty good for avoiding being in other hole's fairways, but can get a little confusing. Map recommended.
<b>Tee pad Type:</b> Concrete
<b>Basket Type:</b> Older Innova DISCatcher
<b>Signage:</b> Signage throughout, not always immediately prominent
<b>Critter Concerns:</b> Rattle Snakes in these here parts so keep your eyes and ears on alert!
<b>Pesky Plants:</b> Mind the thorny things
<b>Total Holes:</b> 18
<b>Favorite Hole:</b> Hole 10 seems the obvious winner, but hole 8 is in a close second for how satisfying it feels to throw successfully.

## Just a Heads Up...

Jeans are probably a better choice over shorts, and hiking boots probably are better than tennis shoes here. There are no services out here so come prepared with whatever you need aka water. Again, a map is recommended. Lastly, once everyone has teed off at hole 10, the path to get down to basket level is BEHIND the tee pad a short distance. *DO NOT FOLLOW THE PATH THAT GOES FORWARD!*
