Terrain: Grassy throughout gaining elevation through the second half.
Shade: Little to no shade for first 11. 12 and beyond mostly shaded.

Popularity: Seems like it is usually pretty empty.

Favored Shot Type: Mostly players choice
Speed of Play: Moderately quick
Layout Quality: Pretty good. Boring at first, but finishes strong. 18 does not end near parking lot by hole 1.
